GUIDELINES FOR ALL BOATERS & VISITORS

NO SMOKING – at Gas Dock, Gas Pump and Gas Tanks. All the marina buildings are smoke free and there is no smoking allowed.

NO SWIMMING – in the marina around the docks, drowning could occur due to electrical current in the water from the boats and shore power.

DOGS – are to be on a leash at all times. Pets are not allowed in Clubhouse. Please remember to Scoop the Poop!

SLIP TENANTS – please keep your boat at your designated slip for the season. Please advise the office if you are leaving the marina on your boat for any length of time and when you expect to return.

PARKING – there is limited parking available. Therefore if you are going to be away on your boat and are leaving a car or two, please advise the office and leave a set of keys.

LAUNCH RAMP – is to be used by marina boaters only. The ramp is not to be used as a public boat launch.

TRANSIENT BOATERS

Please come to the office upon your arrival.

Our marina facilities are for everyone to use. Please be courteous!

If you have any questions or problems regarding the marina, please come to the office and speak to a staff member.

LOYALIST COVE MARINA RULES

Payment - When a boat is launched, hauled out or work is done by Loyalist Cove Marina full payment is due upon receipt of an invoice. Overdue Accounts will be Charged 2% per month. We take Visa, MasterCard, Cheques and Cash. Credit card payments can be arranged over the phone by contacting the marina office.

Pets - Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Please remember to Scoop the Poop.

Clean Marine Policy - You will be required to sign this pledge. Please read it and abide by the clean marine practices.

Mooring & Storage Agreement - A mooring agreement and/or winter storage agreement must be signed by all boat owners. Please read this agreement carefully, as it spells out your responsibilities.

Insurance - We must have current proof of insurance for all boats at Loyalist Cove Marina. Insurance information is required for both wet and dry storage.

Slip Rental and Hydro - Please keep your boat at your assigned slip and do not unplug another boat to hook up to hydro. Hydro is available at most slips, but you must pay for hydro service **before** plugging in.

Third Party Repairs - If you plan to have any repairs performed by an outside contractor while your boat is here at Loyalist Cove, you must let the marina office know and your contractor will have to provide proof of insurance.

Mast Stepping - Please read the mast explanation sheet. You are responsible to pack up and de-rig your mast on the day that the mast is unstepped, so the marina staff can move to the storage area. After launch, your mast will be moved out of storage and placed on sawhorses for you to rig. If you would like our staff to do the de-rigging or rigging work for you, please make arrangements with the marina office.

Cradles - All cradles must be marked with your last name and/or the boat name, as well as the bow and stern marked. **We are not responsible for cradle pads** you must take the pads with you immediately after your boat is launched, and bring the pads back before your boat is hauled out.

Oil Disposal - There is an oil disposal fee for boaters who wish to drop off waste oil. Please make sure you let the marina office know if you would like us to dispose of your used oil and we will make the arrangements.

Winter Storage - We are not responsible for batteries and canvas storage. If you do not wish to leave on board, please take them home. We do not have any storage space at the marina. When you winterize your own boat, only NON TOXIC Antifreeze is allowed to be used in our yard.

Work Orders - If you need repairs performed by Loyalist Cove Marina. **Please make sure a work order is filled out and your boat keys are left at the marina office.**
